Privacy Notice

The Investment Adviser Association respects the privacy of its members and other visitors to its Web site. Information from Web site visitors is collected primarily to help better serve IAA members. The IAA has adopted the following policy in order to protect on-line privacy:

Web Site Privacy

When you visit the IAA's web site, the IAA collects and stores information, including visitor IP addresses, the username you use to log in to restricted areas of the site, the names of all sections of the site that you view or download, and the dates and times of access. The IAA uses collected information to maintain security and to evaluate traffic patterns on our site. The IAA employs the use of encryption and other technologies to help protect all information gathered via its Web site.

The IAA provides its members with access to restricted areas of its Web site. Your login information should never be shared with anyone.

The IAA collects basic contact information from you when you request access to the Member Area of the IAA Web site. That information is collected in order to confirm your association with a member firm and to allow the IAA to notify you of changes in the content or operation of the site.

IAA Member Data

IAA member data is used for IAA-to-member communications. The IAA site includes a list of member firms that is publicly accessible. Membership data is never sold by the IAA to third parties. On occasion, the IAA provides mailing address information to entities that co-sponsor conferences or other events with the IAA so that IAA members can be provided with information about those events.
